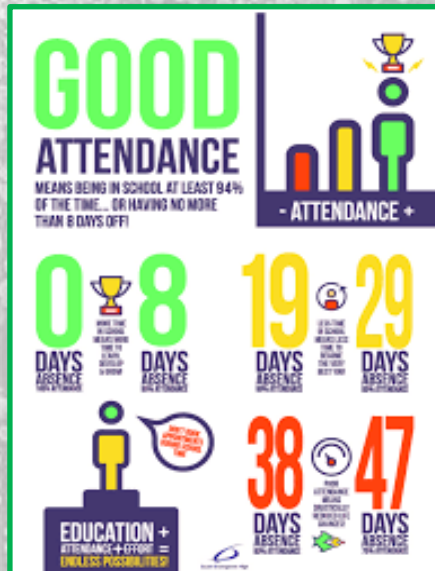

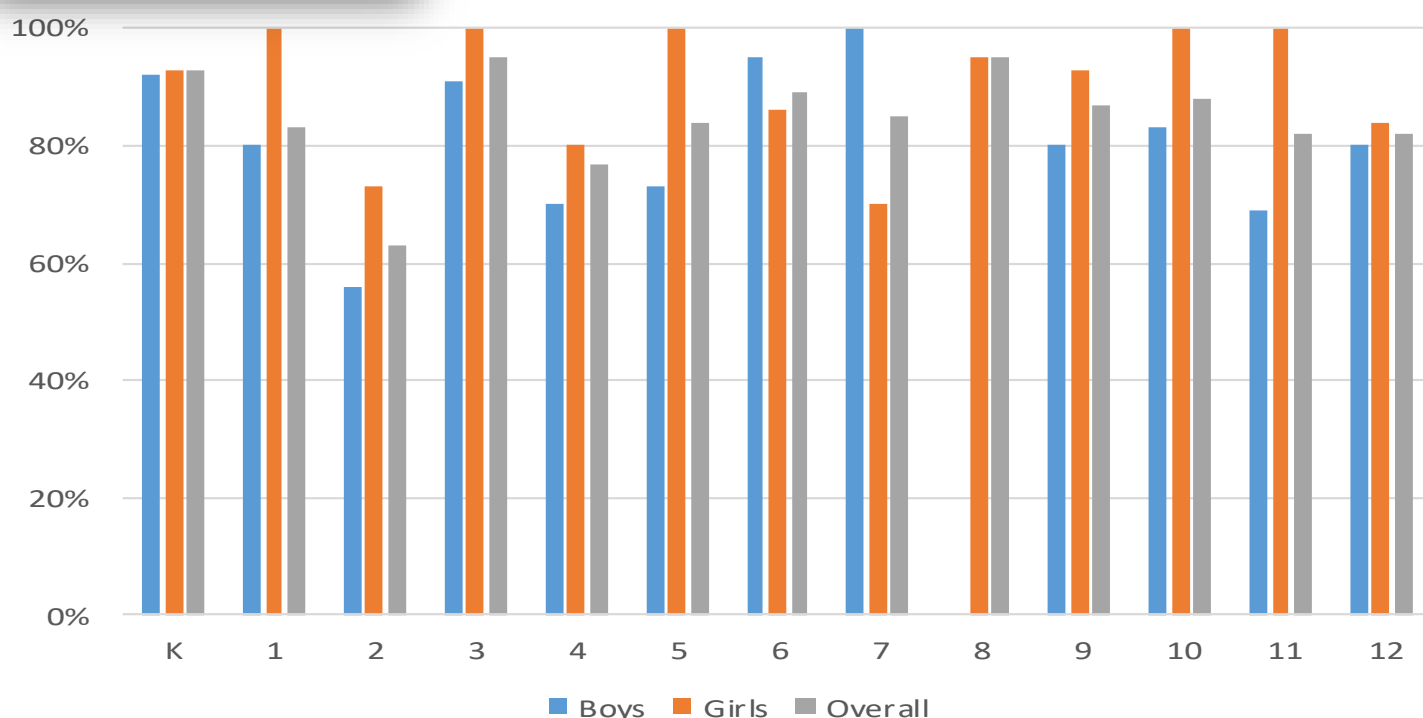

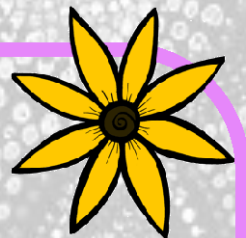

Entries for the 2019 Premier's Spelling Bee will open on Tuesday 30 April 2019.

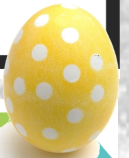
## Who can enter?

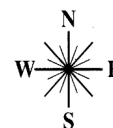

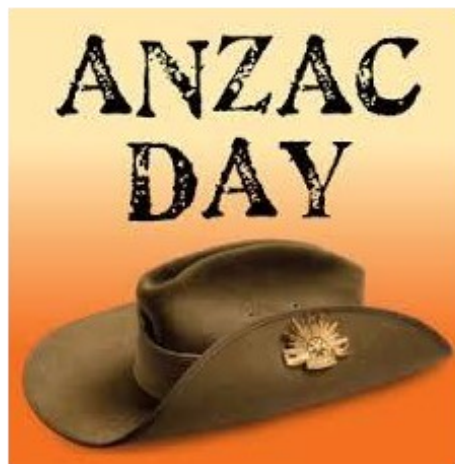
